02.12.2011 Friday	Reporting & Feedback from Trainee Officers Problem given to Trainee RJS Officers relating to Order 21 Rule 97 r/w Sec. 151 CPC for passing order on the problem
03.12.2011 Saturday	Problem given to Trainee RJS Officers relating to Rent Control Act and directed to write order on: one application filed under Order 1 Rule 10 CPC by actual owner and another application filed under Order 7 Rule 11 CPC by defendant.
04.12.2011 Sunday	Problem given to Trainee RJS Officers and directed to prepare a application for Temporary Injunction with reply and pass order relating to stop building construction and cancellation of unauthorized/illegal sale letter.
05.12.2011 Monday	Problem given to Trainee RJS Officers and directed to draft a suit, written statement, frame issues and pass judgment after evidence and argument. Nominate one Trainee Officer as plaintiff, three as defendants, one as advocate of plaintiff and another as advocate of defendants and remaining one Trainee Officer nominate as Judge.
06.12.2011 Tuesday (Idul Fitar)	Broad eye view of Judgment writing in Civil and Criminal cases was given to Trainee RJS Officers along with Order writing on Applications of various provisions in Civil Cases.
07.12.2011 Wednesday	Problem given to Trainee RJS Officers regarding suit for Permanent Injunction and written statement thereof, directed to frame issues and judgment on it. Common Issues were given to Trainee RJS Officers and directed to write Judgment.
